### **PRINCIPAL MISSIONS**

Inform the competitors and play a mediating role at all times.

This post must be entrusted to an official in possession of a licence issued by their ASN as it implies certain knowledge of the general regulations. They may attend the meeting of the panel of the Stewards, in order to keep abreast of all the decisions taken.

The competitors' relation officer must be able to be easily identified by the competitors thanks to a badge or armband and an **ORANGE JACKET**.

#### **PRESENCE DURING THE RALLY**

When the Secretariat is opened, they should have the secretary of the meeting draft a schedule of their duties which shall be posted on the notice board of the rally and which shall include:

-Presence at the regrouping halts

- In the Parc Fermé at end of sections
- Near the Parc Fermé at the finish (the latter being dependent on the rally timetable).



## **D** FUNCTION

- Give accurate answers to all questions asked

- Provide all information or additional clarifications in connection with the Regulations and the running of the rally.

## **© MEDIATION**

Avoid forwarding questions to the Stewards which could be solved satisfactorily by a clear explanation, with the exception of protest (for ex: clarify disputes over times, etc.).

## **D** PLANNING OF THE OFFICERS

In the several starting towns: ACM representatives. From Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup>, February 2018 and until Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> of February 2018, as follow:

## SATURDAY 3rd FEBRUARY:

• VALENCE – Champ de Mars<sup>r</sup> at the Concentration Leg arrival and until the end of the Time Control.

#### SUNDAY 4<sup>th</sup> FEBRUARY:

- VALENCE Champ de Mars: at the Classification Leg start.
- VALENCE Champ de Mars: at the Classification Leg arrival and until the end of the Time Control.

#### **MONDAY 5th FEBRUARY:**

• VALENCE – Champ de Mars: at the start of the 1<sup>st</sup> part Common Leg.

• VALENCE – Champ de Mars: at the arrival of the 1<sup>st</sup> part Common Leg and until the end of the Time Control.

#### **TUESDAY 6<sup>th</sup> FEBRUARY:**

• VALENCE – Champ de Mars: at the start of the 2<sup>nd</sup> part Common Leg.

• **MONACO – Quai Albert 1**<sup>er</sup>: at the arrival of the 2<sup>nd</sup> part Common Leg and until the end of the Time Control.

• MONACO – Quai Albert 1<sup>er</sup>: at the Final Leg start.

#### WEDNESDAY 7<sup>th</sup> FEBRUARY:

• **MONACO – Quai Albert 1**<sup>er</sup>: at the arrival of the Final Leg and until the end of the Time Control.

• **MONACO – Permanence du Rallye at the ACM**: at the publication of the final classification at 12:00am and up to the final claim period (30mm after).
