CONCENTRATION ROUTE :
The 6 Starting Cities are :

Oslo : 18 cars starting Wednesday 31th January from 9.55am for a 1611 km trip.

Glasgow : 18 cars starting for a 2020 km trip from 6pm. Wednesday 31th January

Bad Hombourg : 52 cars will start Friday 2nd February from 2pm for a 1028 km trip.

Barcelone : 38 cars.
Start 2.30pm for 1144 km on Friday.

Reims : 97 cars, Friday from 7pm, 807 km trip.

Monaco : 93 cars from 7pm, 959 km trip. On Friday 2nd February.

They will all meet for the first time in Bourgoin-Jallieu, in Isère on Saturday, from 6.30 am onwards. And then 2 Regularity Zone:

« Le Gua - Saint-Michel-les-Portes / ZR 1 / 39,99 km / 9.40am » and « Col de Pennes - Pradelle / ZR 2 / 16,28 km / 12.40pm ». The last C.H of the day will take place at Crest from 2:10 pm. The crews will then rally, Valence, where the first cars are expected on the «Champ de Mars» at roughlyly 3pm.

For the 21st édition of the Rallye Monte-Carlo Historique 310 crews representing 25 nationalities and 47 brands of cars will be on the starting grid, an alphabet from A to Z, from «Alfa-Roméo» to «Zastava».
