In order to finish the 20th edition of Rallye Monte-Carlo Historique in style, two monuments, for motor racing fans, were on last night's menu: ZR13: Luceram / Lantosque, from 10:10 pm.

ZR14: the mythical Col de Turini, from La Bollène Vésubie to Sospel, at 11:04 pm. The crews were due back at 1:20 am in the Monaco Parc Fermé.

Belgian crew Decremer/Albert were in the lead when they started the penultimate ZR of the 20th Rallye Monte-Carlo Historique (Lucéram / Lantosque).

However, with the Top 10 crews held into a 500-point difference only, one could suspect that this last night was going to be crucial.

On paper, Monégasque crew Daniel Elena / Olivier Campana, 10th after ZR12, had enough assets in its game to plan a spectacular come-back, thanks to their experience and perfect knowledge of the roads.

COL DE TURINI

Altitude: 1607 mètres

Road conditions were dry in the famous Col de Turini.

No risk of black ice, thanks to the relatively warm conditions on the French Riviera and in the hills behind.

The choice of tyres was quick and easy, with no need for studded or winter compounds.

Classification: **ZR14**

These conditions were a bit too ideal to make a significant difference on the roads. So the Top 10 in ZR14 finished in a 20-point bag!

Belgian leaders Michel Decremer and Yannick Albert (Opel Ascona), heading the race since ZR8, held it tight and stayed on top, followed very closely (100 points) by Italian crew Aghem / Cumino (Lancia Fulvia 1200).

There was a lot of pressure in the last two ZRs, but the Belgians managed it well... and won this 20th edition of Rallye Monte-Carlo Historique!

The last step on the podium is for another Italian crew and car, Fontanella/Scrivani (Fiat 128 Coupé).

The 6th spot is for the best Monégasque crew, Daniel Elena / Olivier Campana (VW Golf GTI), ahead of the best French team in 7th place, Raymond Durand/Sébastien Chol, in their Opel Kadett GTE of Team AGEA.
