1. PRESENTATION

Dear Competitors,

Some changes have been made to the 88th Monte-Carlo Rally programme - in particular, administrative checks now begin on Sunday 19th January in Monaco and reconnaissance will start on Monday 20th at 08:00 a.m.

The 2020 Rally will start at Place du Casino in Monte-Carlo, at 17:00 on Thursday 23rd January, allowing Monaco to be the hub for promotional activities and the event to start with two night-time specials. The first is from Malijai to Puimichel, 17.72 km (20:38): starting at the exit of Digne-les-Bains, this special stage (which is longer than the 1994 version) follows the Bléone valley before climbing up to Puimichel. The second special runs between Bayons and Bréziers, 25.49 km (22:26) in the Hautes Alpes department, returning to the Gap Service Park, near Fontreyne Stade Nautique (Swimming Stadium), from 23:31.

Shakedown takes place the day before, on Wednesday 22nd January, on Route de la Garde in Gap, (identical route to previous years) between 16:00 and 20:00.

Friday, the second race day, will be the hardest of the event, with 122.90 km of special stages (SS), split into 3 stages run twice, in Hautes Alpes and Alpes de Hautes Provence. First, to the southeast of Gap, SS 3/6 "Curbans - Venterol", a variation on "Curbans - Piégut" which was run in 2019. This has a new stage distance of 20.10 km with the first car scheduled to leave at 08:36 on the first run and 13:53 on the second run. Then a completely new stage for this second day, the northernmost SS in the Hautes Alpes department, running between St Clément and Freissinières, covering 20.76 km and located on a northeast slope overlooking la Durance, which should theoretically ensure good snowfall (starts at 09:54 and 15:11).

Finally, the third SS of the day (which was held once at night in 2019) is less than 15 km from Gap: the "Avançon - Notre-Dame-du-Laus", 20.59 km, starts at 11:17 and 17:34. Friday will be the most intense day of the Monte-Carlo Rally with more than a third of total special stage distance covered on one day.

On Saturday, 25th January, we return to the classic special running between St-Léger-les-Mélèzes and la Bâtie-Neuve and passing through the ski slopes of Col de Moissière, 16.87 km (09:38 and 14:08), to be broadcast live on Canal+. This alternates with the "La Bréole - Selonnet" stage (20.82 km), held in daytime unlike last year's Selonnet route, but run twice and likely to attract a large number of roadside spectators. Start times are scheduled for 11:01 and 15:26.

The second visit to the Fontreyne Gap Service Park will be the last because competitors return to Monaco at the end of the day, to arrive in the Principality from 21:24 onwards (early check-in allowed).

A good night's recovery will be needed after this return trip to Monaco to prepare for the final stage on Sunday 26th January, which will be identical in all aspects to 2019 and 2018. The two stages "La Bollène-Vesubie - Peira Cava" and "La Cabanette - Col de Braus" total 63.80 km, with the 16th and final SS once again the "Power Stage" and scoring bonus points for the top five finishers. The finish of the SS 14/16 has been brought backward slightly to make the last few hundred metres more secure.

The Prize-giving Ceremony will again be held on Quai Albert 1^{er}, starting at 15:00, where a maximum of spectators will be able to gather at this historic venue that has celebrated so many Rally finishes.

5.3 Service Park regulation and environmental requirements

5.3.1 Environmental requirements

The emptying of waste water, the car washing and the drilling of stakes into the ground are not permitted in the Service Park. Any infringement will be reported to the Stewards who may apply penalties.



5.3.2 Service Park rules

Trucks and trailers must evacuate the Service Park no later than **Saturday 18th January 2020 - 08h00** in order to keep the Service Park clear for the other Competitors. These vehicles must be parked in parking P1 ERDF, route de la Luye. Failure to do so risk a 1500 € penalty per vehicle paid immediately to the Organiser.

Only vehicles displaying a « Service » sticker are authorized to enter the Service Park. If these vehicles do not fit in the Service Park Competitors' allocated area, they must be parked in the dedicated parking.

However, these vehicles must not be driven in the lanes used by the competing cars 15 minutes prior to the expected arrival of the first Competitor at TC SP IN until the last Competitor has checked-in at TC SP OUT.

Vehicles displaying « Auxiliary » or « Route Note Car » stickers must compulsory park in the dedicated parking.

6. TWO-WAY RADIOS

6.1 Registration procedure

The temporary use of radio frequencies on the Monegasque and French territories is subject to prior approval.

9. HELICOPTERS

9.1 Registration procedure

In accordance with the FIA Safety Regulations and the requirements of the Civil Aviation authorities, all helicopters participating in the Rally must be registered with the Organiser.



The registration form (Appendices 2 and 3) must be submitted **before Friday 27th December 2019**.

The fee due to the Organiser is 2000 € per helicopter (500 € for costs incurred will not be reimbursed if weather conditions are unfavourable and no flight can be made).

A compulsory helicopter pilots briefing will be held on **Thursday 23rd January 2020 at 17h00** at the Rally HQ, Centre Omnisport COSEC, Avenue de Traunstein, 05000 GAP.
