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A very large crowd was waiting for the crews this afternoon on the Champ de Mars in Valence. At the end of the Classification Leg, and after going through four regularity tests during the day, the Italian and Spanish crew made of Luca Travagliati / Eloy Alsina behind the wheel of a Porsche 911 S 2.2 is leading.

The traditional popular fervour of the inhabitants of Drôme and Ardèche was even greater this year. A huge crowd had gathered to welcome the 19th edition of **Rallye Historique Monte-Carlo** in the streets and near the podium located on Champs de Mars in Valence.

Tomorrow, the first part of the Common Leg will include a loop of four legendary Regularity Tests, going through **Le Moulinon, Antraigues, Burzet, Saint-Bonnet-le-Froid, Lamastre**, so many names that marked the history of **Rallye Automobile de Monte-Carlo**. The teams still in the race will regroup in the heart of the prefecture of the Drôme department in the middle of the afternoon for a restful night.

Today, the crews had to go through four Regularity Tests between **Monaco, Sisteron, Saint-Nazaire-en-Royans** and **Valence** for the Classification Leg, marked by the presence of a large audience on the side of the roads and in the cities and villages.

Significant retirements

Petter Granerud, who ended at the second place in 2014, couldn't make it to **Monaco** yesterday evening because of a mechanical failure on his Porsche 911 SC.

Jean-Christophe Vouillon, a regular of the monégasque event, had no choice but to retire during the Concentration Route because of a problem with the alternator. He was 16th in 2012.

Another victim of the first part of the rally, the "London Cab" wasn't any better than his 1961 predecessor. The crew had to retire because of brake issues on their Austin.

This morning, two top crews didn't take the start this morning for the Classification Leg:

The triple winner **José Lareppe**, now 288th (last position), had to retire because of an issue on the throttle cable. The Belgian preferred not to continue the race.

Jean Ragnotti, suffering from severe back pain, after the race behind the wheel of the Renault 5 Turbo yesterday, retired. We wish him a prompt recovery.
