



Le QUOTIDIEN of the 22nd Rallye Monte-Carlo Historique 2019 will be available everyday on the official website of the Automobile Club de Monaco (www.acm.mc), on the social networks of the Automobile Club de Monaco and on the application ACM Live (available on App Store and Google Play).



VALENCE: THE VILLAGE OF THE RALLYE MONTE-CARLO HISTORIQUE MOVED TO THE **GEORGES POMPIDOU STADIUM**

On account of a major regional meeting of "Yellow Jackets" this Saturday 2nd February and at the Drome's Prefecture request, the arrivals of the competitors and all the festivities organized around the 22th Rallye Monte-Carlo Historique, initially planned on the Champs de Mars, will be exceptionally held at the Georges Pompidou Stadium. (41 Rue Fernandel, 26000 Valence).

The arrivals of the cars will take place on Saturday February 2nd (after a 2 hours regrouping in Crest) at 5.20 pm, on Sunday February 3rd at 4.40 pm and on Monday February 4th at 3.30 pm.

From Saturday February 2nd to Wednesday February 5th, the village at the Goerges Pompidou stadium will welcome the 25 000 visitors expected and will offer numerous activities for adults and children (car and motorbike exposing, tastings, trial of historical vehicles... etc).

27 CARS START AT 2PM

This day began with the start from Bad Homburg at 2PM. 27 cars left Germany to participate to the 22nd edition of the Rallye Monte-Carlo Historique.

This Friday Reims hosts the start of the Rallye Monte-Carlo Historique.

With Monaco it's the only city not to have missed any of the 21 editions since 1988.

For this 22nd edition the city of Reims is awarded by the presence of 85 crews who will start this Friday at 7pm, from the cathedral.

MILAN

63 CARS START AT 6PM

For the first time in the history, Milan is a starting city of the Rallye Monte-Carlo Historique. 63 cars will start a trip of 840 kilometers from 6PM.

They leave from Milan and drive a legendary Alpine A110 which will display the "pink ribbon", symbol of "Europa Donna" to promote awareness of breast cancer.












ONE WEEK AFTER OGIER AND INGRASSIA TRIUMPH...

2019 marks the 50th anniversary of John's 12th place finish on the 1969 Monte Carlo Rally in a Porsche 911T, co-driven by Stephen Behr. 1969 was a famous year for Porsche: Björn Waldegård and Lars Helmer took victory in a 911S, followed by the 911 of Larousse and Perramond.

Which better way to celebrate than racing again the legendary Monte-Carlo? By doing it with the same car...of course!
