### ⇒ PRINCIPAL MISSIONS

Inform the competitors and play a mediating role at all times.

This post must be entrusted to an official in possession of a licence issued by their ASN as it implies certain knowledge of the general regulations. They may attend the meeting of the panel of the Stewards, in order to keep abreast of all the decisions taken.

The competitor's relation officer must be able to be easily identified by the competitors thanks to a badge or armband and an **ORANGE JACKET**.

### ⇒ PRESENCE DURING THE RALLY

When the Secretariat is opened, they should have the secretary of the meeting draft a schedule of their duties which shall be posted on the notice board of the rally and which shall include:

- Presence at the regrouping halts
- In the Parc Fermé at end of sections
- Near the Parc Fermé at the finish (the latter being dependent on the rally timetable).

### ⇒ FUNCTION

- Give accurate answers to all questions asked
- Provide all information or additional clarifications in connection with the Regulations and the running of the rally.

### ⇒ MEDIATION

Avoid forwarding questions to the Stewards which could be solved satisfactorily by a clear explanation, with the exception of protest (for ex: clarify disputes over times, etc.).



## **➔ PLANNING OF THE OFFICERS**

### **FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 2:**

- ♦ **MONACO – Quai Albert 1<sup>er</sup>**: at the arrival of Common Leg part 3 and until the end of the CH
- ♦ **MONACO – Quai Albert 1<sup>er</sup>**: at the start of the Final Leg stage and until the end of the CH

### **WENESDAY, FEBRUARY 7:**

- ♦ **MONACO – Quai Albert 1<sup>er</sup>**: at the arrival of the Final Leg stage and until the end of the CH
- ♦ **MONACO – Permanence of the Rally at ACM**: At the publication of the Final Ranking at 12:00 and during the protest period (30mm)
