20. SOLBERG-EDMONDSON

"Good loop. Tricky conditions, I'm trying different tyres so I'm still learning a lot, but it's good fun out there."

21. GRYAZIN-ALEKSANDROV

"It was okay. The first stage was difficult and we did small mistakes in the second stage. The last was better."

22. ROSSEL-DUNAND

"Very good morning, everything is going pretty well for us. We hope to continue on this path."

23. GREENSMITH-ANDERSSON

"Horrible morning. I hope it will get better this afternoon."

24. DAPRÀ-GUGLIELMETTI

"Better than yesterday. We are faster and closer to the first drivers. The pace is almost the same as yesterday and we are trying to be more confident with the car, especially in the big cuts. We are happy with our tyre choice and the setup of the car, so, let's continue like this."

25. MUNSTER-PASCAUD

"Good morning, even if we made a small mistake on the last stage, on the uphill section where there was a bit of snow. We lost a bit of time that we managed to make up in the last part which was greasy, which means that we have a good base but we still have a bit of speed to find. These are stages that I'm not used to drive, but I think we're not doing too badly for a first time here."

26. KOGURE-LUHTINEN

"All good. Better feeling than yesterday. Drier conditions but with more cuts and mud. I feel more confident."

27. BURRI-LEVRATTI

"It's complicated, you have to find pace. Other drivers are very fast. I'm hesitating a bit, too much braking and it quickly makes a difference in the time. Yesterday we drove all day on snow tires, it's the first time we've put on slicks so I have to get used to it. I'm finding pace little by little."



28. POTTY-HERMAN

"It's difficult, with real Monte-Carlo conditions. There are a lot of changes between the passage of the gravel crew and ours. There is a lot of degradation. We tried adjustments on the car but we will surely rethink about it to try to start the second loop well."

29. BOLAND-MJ

"We got a red flag in the first one but the next two were okay. Very slippery but we got no problem."

31. CAMILLI-DE LA HAYE

"The morning went pretty well, a bit of difficulty in the first stage. We started with hard tyres, which was the mistake not to make and we had to make up for it with a few changes. It was better towards the end of the morning."

34. ROSSEL-MERCOIRET

"It's our best morning since the start of the rally, even our best loop. But we made a small mistake in the second. We were lucky not to get a puncture but that's part of the rally."

36. BREGA-ZEGNA

"The first and second were so-so and the third was very good."

37. ČERNY-KRAJČA

"First stage was very nice, we enjoyed it a lot but it's very difficult. Lots of cuts, lots of mud; a propre rally."

38. KOHN-WHITTOCK

"Tricky morning. I couldn't stay focused and I had quite a hard time. We want to prepare and correct our pace notes for this afternoon in order to get a better feeling."

39. SARRAZIN-COMBE

"It's better than yesterday, we're starting to gain confidence. We can only do better in the second loop now that we've seen what awaits us. I can't wait for this afternoon."





42. RUMEAU-AMBLARD

"A great morning for us with three big stages. The first was quite wet, we expected it to dry out more. We're pretty happy. We need to be more consistent on the splits to put it all together. This morning, we managed to have more fun and let loose more. The car is working really well. It's really positive and we'll try to keep improving this afternoon. Let's see what the weather forecast has in store for us."

43. MICHELLOD-FELLAY

"We had a lot of fun this morning. The stages are very different from yesterday. We were comfortable and we were able to set some pretty decent times. It's still very dirty but it's fun overall."

45. GUEX-GUIEU

"It wasn't the conditions we were expecting. We were told that the stages would be dry and smooth, but that's not what we got. We were a bit surprised, but it was still nice."

46. BRAZZOLI-MUSIARI

"Good morning. The stages are very tricky, slippery and muddy. But I enjoyed these conditions."

47. CHIARANI-ZANELLA

"Good morning, the stages are quite dirty. Unfortunately, we had a puncture in one stage, which made us lose time. But overall, it's going well and we're happy."

49. VOSSEN-VISSENBERG

"Very nice but in the first stage we were stopped because there was a car on fire. The next two were fantastic, but very slippery and trick. Still, it was nice to get through them both."

50. DOMINGUEZ-PEÑATE

"Quite tricky, there was a lot of pollution on the road so we took it very easy to get through."

52. ROSSI-SARMEZAN

"We lost a lot of time, we'll have to pull ourselves together this afternoon, but it's not lost yet. We have to make a few small changes, regain our confidence back and push. We'll see where we are at tonight."





54. FONTANA-ARNABOLDI

"Good morning. I had a good pace in the two stages we could complete. Very slippery, a lot of cuts with mud so it was difficult but we did a good job."

56. PELAMOURGUES-POUGET

"We're starting to slow down the pace so as not to make any mistakes and manage our lead as best we can. We had a big spin in third gear and I maneuvered like a someone who was passing his or her driving test."

40. DELECOUR-ROCHE

"The morning didn't go as planned unfortunately. We had a handbrake problem, which cost us two straights in two successive hairpins. The conditions weren't made for a two-wheel drive because there is a lot of degradation. We're suffering a bit, we're trying to give the best of ourselves, but it's not easy against the four-wheel drive ahead of us. They are very fast."

59. POIZOT-GRAND

"Everything is fine, we are here. We had a great time this morning, better than yesterday and we are looking forward to arriving at the start of the next loop."

60. DOLCE-GIROUD

"The morning didn't go very well. One kilometer into the second stage, we broke the gearbox linkage and we had to do the whole special in second gear. Which was very complicated. We were able to repair it with a piece of wire to at least change gears and get to Gap. We did the third special in third gear to get there and try to repair the ball joint."

62. BARNEAUD-BARNEAUD

"The morning went well, we had more fun than yesterday."

77. SAUNIER-VAUCLARE

"We made a very bad tyre choice by starting with the hard. We thought it would be a super bold strategy. But it was so muddy and destroyed that we had a lot of trouble. We made a big attack and we were able to save the day."

78. CHARNAY-GOMEZ

"We made the right choice of tyres this morning. We would have loved to do the first stage, which we really liked, but there was a red flag. It's only a postponement for this afternoon in the second loop. We'll try to do as well this afternoon."
