#### 1.INTRODUCTION

Despite facing multiple administrative and regulatory challenges, the Automobile Club of Monaco's Organizing Committee has successfully finalized the framework of the 94th Rallye Automobile Monte-Carlo - a feat requiring precision and flexibility. As the opening round of the 2026 FIA World Rally Championship (WRC), this legendary road event is poised to attract high-caliber teams and elite drivers from across the globe.

Reconnaissance runs will be conducted from Sunday, January 18 through Tuesday, January 20. Participating crews will then engage in a modified shakedown session on January 21 at 14:01. Measuring 4.80 km, the trial route - first introduced in 2017 and extended for this edition - now integrates the Rabou's road in Gap, host city from 2014 to 2021 and again from 2024.

The official start of the 94<sup>th</sup> Rallye Automobile Monte-Carlo is set for **Thursday, January 22** at **14:30** from the podium ramp installed on **Quai Albert 1**er in **Monaco**. This initial leg features three special stages, totaling 61.58 kilometers. Held in the departments of Alpes-Maritimes and Alpes-de-Haute-Provence, the stages « Toudon / Saint-Antonin » (SS 1 - 22,90 km - 16h05), « Esclangon / Seyne-les-Alpes » (SS 2 - 23,48 km - 18h38) and « Vaumeilh / Claret » (SS 3 - 15,20 km - 20h35) promise the potential for major surprises right from the start.

Two departments, Drôme and Hautes-Alpes, will host the second day of rallying, with a total of 129.38 kilometers against the clock. This leg comprises a three-stage loop repeated twice, including « Laborel / Chauvac-Laux-Montaux » (SS 4/7 - 17,84 km - 08h54/15h16), «Saint-Nazaire-le-Désert / La Motte-Chalancon » (SS 5/8 - 29,00 km - 10h22/16h44) and « La Bâtie-des-Fonts / Aspremont » (SS 6/9 - 17,85 km - 11h40/18h05). This second leg, packed with technical challenges, is simply the longest of the entire rally.

While shorter in length, Saturday's mostly Alpes-de-Haute-Provence-based stage remains equally demanding. It features a total of 78.22 kilometers of timed sections, including the band-new « La Bréole / Bellaffaire » via the Garcinets pass (SS 10/12 - 30,10 km - 08h01/12h01), run twice, and a daytime reprise of « Vaumeilh / Claret » from Thursday evening (SS 11 - 15,20 km - 09h15). In contrast to the 2025 edition, this year the return to Monaco happens Saturday afternoon and wraps up with a super special stage - currently under consideration – the first since 2008 (SS 13 - 2,82 km - 18h05), set on the lower section of the iconic Monaco Circuit.

Rallye Automobile Monte-Carlo will culminate with a thrilling final showdown across two legendary mountain stages, each repeated twice and totaling 71.62 kilometers. Crews will tackle « Col de Braus / La Cabanette » (SS 14/16 - 12,48 km - 08h05/11h09) and « La Bollène-Vésubie / Moulinet » (SS 15/17 - 23,33 km -09h35/13h15), with the second run of the latter serving as the Wolf Power Stage - a decisive moment where drivers can gain crucial championship points. The rally will officially conclude with the final podium and awards ceremony held at Port Hercule, beginning at 17:00...

#### 4.2 Entry procedure

The closing date for entries is **Friday**, **19**<sup>th</sup> **December 2025** at 23:59 (CET).

Manufacturers, P2 and P3 competitors who wish to score points in FIA Championships, must make their entries by using the electronic standard rally entry form for their championships available in the FIA website.

Any non-priority competitor wishing to take part in 94° RALLYE AUTOMOBILE MONTE-CARLO must register and duly complete the electronic entry form published in the FIA website, before the closing date for entries.

The entry application will only be accepted if accompanied by the total amount of the entry fee.

In addition to submitting the online registration entry form to the FIA, the competitors are also required to send the following documents to rallye@acm.mc before the closing of entries:

- Proof of payment of the total amount of entry fees
- Copies of the driver and co-driver passports or identity cards





- Copies of the international competition licenses of the competitor, Driver and Codriver
- Copies of the driver and co-driver driving licences
- One identity photo of the driver and co-driver
- Copy of the first page of the car homologation certificate (not for Rally1 cars)
- Copy of the car registration certificate or proof of ownership
- Copy of the entry form duly signed
- Copy of the competition license of the route note car driver (International if P1/P2 or National)

By entering the rally, the competitor and the crew submit themselves to the sporting jurisdictions specified in the 2026 FIA International Sporting Code and its appendices, the 2026 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations and the Supplementary Regulations of the rally.

#### 4.3 Number of entrants accepted and categories

The maximum number of crews will be 70. If more than 70 entries are received, the organiser reserves the right to decide which entries among the non-priority drivers will be accepted. Cars will be divided in classes (and groups) as indicated in the 2026 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations.

The classification "Promotion" is reserved to non-priority competitors entered as private competitor and never had a FIA priority P1, P2 or P3.

#### 5.3 Service Park regulations and environmental requirements

#### 5.3.1 Environmental requirements

It is forbidden under any circumstances to drill holes in the surface of the Service Park.

Teams and competitors are asked to bring weights for tents and other items, which must be securely fastened.

Teams and competitors must ensure that no fuel, waste water or other liquids leak onto the ground. Floor mats must be used.

Washing of vehicles and spare parts is forbidden in the service park.

A washing area will be set up at the entrance to the service park.

Illegal electrical connections to street furniture are strictly forbidden.

Any violations of the recycling instructions given for the service park area will entail the following penalties:

- 1<sup>st</sup> infringement: a fine of 1 000 € notified by the Clerk of the Course
- 2<sup>nd</sup> infringement: a fine of 2 000 € notified by the Clerk of the Course
- 3<sup>rd</sup> infringement: will be reported to the Stewards

#### 5.3.2 Regulations

Only vehicles identified "Service", "Auxiliary" or "Route Note Car" are allowed in the service park. If these vehicles do not fit in the competitors allocated area, they must be parked outside the service park.

These vehicles must not be driven in the lanes used by the competing cars 30 minutes prior to the expected arrival of the first competitor at TC service park IN until the last competitor has checked-in at TC service park OUT.

Any vehicle which is not parked inside the competitor's allocated area in the service park will result in a penalty of 1,500 € per vehicle. Any such application of the regulations by the Clerk of the Course will be notified to the competitor concerned.

The circulation of any vehicle with a Total Loaded Weight (PTAC) greater than 3.5 tonnes is prohibited on the Monegasque territory between 08.00am and 09.00am

#### 6. TWO-WAY RADIO

The temporary use of radio frequencies on the Monegasque and French territories is subject to prior approval. The forms available on www.acm.mc may be completed and returned to the concerned authorities.

# 8. IMPORT OF VEHICLES AND SPARE PARTS

Vehicles from the European Union do not need a specific document for Customs clearance. Only non-EU competitors will need to show an ATA (obtainable from the Chamber of Commerce of the country of origin) to Customs Authorities at their point of entry into the European Union. #### 9. HELICOPTERS

In accordance with articles L363-1 to L363-3 of the French Environment Code, amended by law no. 2022-217 of February 21, 2022, article 63, which prohibits the landing of aircraft for commercial purposes in mountainous areas (+800m altitude), helicopters intended for VIPs will no longer be authorized.

Only security and television helicopters will be allowed.

#### 10. HOSPITALITY ARRANGEMENTS

Access to the special stages' public zones and to the service park of the 94e Rallye Automobile Monte-Carlo are free for spectators.

#### 15. START PROCEDURE

The start of the "94° Rallye Automobile Monte-Carlo" will take place on Thursday, 22<sup>nd</sup> **January 2025** at 14:30 - Quai Albert 1er. The holding area and tyre fitting zone preceding the starting podium will be open from 09:00. Each competitor will park in a slot identified by his competition number. Parc Fermé rules will not apply to this holding area and tyre fitting

First car shall drive on the starting podium (TC 0) 3 minutes before its due time for interviews. Following cars shall drive on the starting podium immediately after the previous car has started.

#### 16. FINISH PROCEDURE

After TC17B, competitors will enter the Parc Fermé and park in front of their competition number.

All competitors must be present in the Parc Fermé at 16:45.

Teams of the top-three competitors in the overall classification and those of the competitors selected for the final scrutineering must arrange for a mechanic to be present beside the podium. The mechanic will retrieve the car from the podium, drive it down and park at the base of it, where a scrutineer will get on board of the cars submitted for the final scrutineering.

The Parc Fermé regime will apply from TC17A until the Stewards open the Parc Fermé.

## 18.2 Accreditation procedure

- 1. A maximum of three representatives (journalist and/or photographers) per publication may be accredited for the 94° Rallye Automobile Monte-Carlo.
  - Only one pass will be issued to websites. Photo, TV or radio tabards are not issued for websites.
- 2. Agencies must meet the same criteria as publications. The central offices or premises of the main international agencies will be accredited by the FIA.
- 3. To be accredited, Media must have a distribution that meets criteria of quality and quantity of the FIA.
- 4. The advertising, public relation, marketing, agencies, etc.... shall in no case be accredited as Media, and Organiser will not issue accreditation to representatives (press officer or otherwise) of sponsors, suppliers, manufacturers, drivers, etc....
- 5. A Media holding a permanent pass issued by the FIA and wishing an additional accreditation for journalist and/or photographers must apply directly on the FIA website.

#### 18.2.2 Procedures

- 1. Foreign Media must submit their request on the FIA website before Friday, 2<sup>nd</sup> January 2026: https://www.fia.com/mediacenter/media accreditation/World%20Rally%20Championship
- 2. Monegasque Media must submit their request on the ACM website before Friday, 26<sup>th</sup> Decembre 2025: www.acm.mc
- 3. Press photographers under contract with agencies or publications must provide documentation justifying the publication of a minimum of 15 pictures of the previous edition (2025).





- 4. The request must include:
- The accreditation form completed;
- An application for accreditation on an official letterhead paper of the media or agency and signed by the editor or publisher;
- A copy of the publication and information diffusion (distribution, readership, frequency...) just for first-time applicants;
- Copies of the published articles covering the 2025 FIA World Rally Championship and possibly those dealing with the Rallye Automobile Monte-Carlo 2025;
- A photocopy of the press card of the representative who will cover the Rallye Automobile Monte-Carlo 2026:
- Information on the coverage provided for the Rallye Automobile Monte-Carlo 2026, with details on release dates or broadcast.
- 5. Documents submitted late and/or incomplete will not be considered.
