1. INTRODUCTION

The oldest road rally is set to write a new chapter in its history. And for this 95th edition, the Rallye Monte-Carlo aims to reaffirm its status as the flagship event on the international calendar. As the opening round of the 2027 FIA World Rally Championship*, the event organized by the Organizing Committee of Automobile Club de Monaco (ACM) combines a prestigious heritage with a revamped route, already heralded as formidably selective!

Following the reconnaissance runs, scheduled from **Sunday 17 to Tuesday 19 January**, the crews authorised to start will gather on **Wednesday 20 January** for the **Shakedown (4.25 km)** starting at **14:01**, to get their bearings in race conditions. This set-up session has been modified in 2026 and now follows the **Routes de la Garde** and **de Rabou in Gap**, the host town for the event from 2014 to 2021, and once again from 2024 onwards.

The official start of this **95th edition of the Rallye Monte-Carlo** is scheduled for the following day, **Thursday 21 January at 13:45**, from the podium erected on **Port Hercule in Monaco**. The program for this first leg features three timed special stages, totalling **70.22 kilometres**. Taking place in the **Alpes-Maritimes** and **Alpes-de-Haute-Provence** departments, the stages are: **'Col de Bleine / Aiglun' (SS 1 - 25.47 km - 15:35)**, **'Clumanc / Lambruisse' (SS 2 - 20.95 km - 18:05)** and **'Esclangon / Seyne-les-Alpes' (SS 3 - 23.80 km - 20:05)**. They will require constant vigilance right from the start.

Friday 22 January sees the action head north of **Gap** for the second day of rallying, spread across two departments (**Hautes-Alpes and Isère**) for a total of **100.56 kilometres** against the clock. The route features a loop of three special stages to be completed twice, comprising **'Agnières-en-Dévoluy / Pellafol' (SS 4/7 - 17.20 km - 09:25/14:45)**, **'La Salle-en-Beaumont / Les Côtes-de-Corps' (SS 5/8 - 14.40 km - 10:25/15:45)** and finally **'Saint-Maurice / Aubessagne' (SS 6/9 - 18.68 km - 11:25/16:45)**. It goes without saying that this leg promises to be anything but a foregone conclusion!

Heading west on **Saturday 23 January**, the third day of racing will take place across two departments (**Hautes-Alpes and Drôme**) over a total of **112.92** timed kilometres. With a loop of three special stages to be tackled twice, just like the day before, this is sure to be the trickiest day to navigate. On the program for this longest day of the rally are **'Laborel / Montauban-sur-l'Ouvèze' (SS 10/13 - 18.58 km - 08:05/15:05)**, **'Saint-Nazaire-le-Désert / La Motte-Chalancon' (SS 11/14 - 22.00 km - 10:05/17:05)** and **'La Bâtie-des-Fonts / Sigottier' (SS 12/15 - 15.88 km - 11:15/18:25)**, with no doubt just as many twists and turns in store as during the first two days.

To round off the event, on **Sunday 24 January**, three special stages totalling **69.87 kilometres** are to be covered between **Gap** and **Monaco** for this final stage, where the ultimate showdown will take place between the timed sections of **'Clumanc / Lambruisse' (SS 16 - 20.95 km - 08:00)**, **'Col de Bleine / Aiglun' (SS 17 - 25.47 km - 09:40)** and finally **'La Bollène-Vésubie / Moulinet' (SS 18 - 23.45 km - 13:15)**, which will serve as the **Power Stage**. Finally, the prize-giving ceremony is scheduled to take place on **Port Hercule in Monaco from 17h00...**

Note: All timings and distances are provisional until publication of the official itinerary.

4.1 Titles for which the rally counts

4.2 Entry procedure

The closing date for entries is **Sunday, 20th December 2026** at 23:59 (CET).

Manufacturers, P2 and P3 competitors who wish to score points in FIA Championships, must make their entries by using the electronic standard rally entry form for their championships available in the FIA website.

Any non-priority competitor wishing to take part in 95^e RALLYE AUTOMOBILE MONTE-CARLO must register and fill in the electronic entry form published at <https://registrations.fia.com/wrcmon> duly completed before the closing date for entries.

The entry application will only be accepted if accompanied by the total amount of the entry fee. In addition to submitting the online registration form to the FIA, competitors are also required to submit the following documents to the platform before the registration deadline via the link: [Competitors' area RAMC 2027](#)

- Proof of payment of the total amount of entry fees
- Copies of the Driver and Co-driver passports or identity cards
- Copies of the Competitor, Driver and Co-driver International Competition Licences
- Copy of the RNC Driver Competition licence (Internationale if P1/P2 or Nationale for the others)
- Copies of the Driver and Co-driver driving licences
- One identity photo of the Driver and Co-driver (in JPEG or PNG)
- Copy of the first page of the car homologation papers (not for Rally1 cars)
- Copies of the car's registration papers or proof of ownership
- Copy of the entry form duly signed
- Service structure form

By entering the rally, the competitor and the crew submit themselves to the sporting jurisdictions specified in the 2027 FIA International Sporting Code and its appendices, the 2027 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations and these Supplementary Regulations (2027 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations, Art. 22.5).

4.3 Number of competitors accepted and classes

The maximum number of crews will be 65. If more than 65 entries are received, the organiser reserves the right to decide which entries among the non-priority drivers will be accepted. Cars will be divided in classes (and groups) as indicated in Article 12.4 of the 2027 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations.

The classification "Promotion" is reserved to non-priority competitors entered as private competitor and never had a FIA priority P1, P2, P3 or P4.

5.3 Service Park regulations and environmental requirements

5.3.1 Environmental requirements

It is forbidden under any circumstances to drill holes in the surface of the Service Park.

Teams and competitors are asked to bring weights for tents and other items, which must be securely fastened.

Teams and competitors must ensure that no fuel, waste water or other liquids leak onto the ground. Floor mats must be used.

Washing of vehicles and spare parts is forbidden in the service park.

A washing area will be set up at the entrance to the service park.

Unauthorized power supply from street fittings is forbidden.

Any violations of the recycling instructions given for the service park area will entail the following penalties:

- **1st infringement: a fine of 1 000 € notified by the Clerk of the Course**
- **2nd infringement: a fine of 2 000 € notified by the Clerk of the Course**
- **3rd infringement: will be reported to the Stewards**

5.3.2 Regulations

Only vehicles identified “Service”, “Auxiliary” or “Route Note Car” are allowed in the service park. If these vehicles do not fit in the competitors’ allocated area, they must be parked outside the service park, in the parking P2: [44°32'17.8"N 6°03'17.8"E](#)

These vehicles must not be driven in the lanes used by the competing cars 30 minutes prior to the expected arrival of the first competitor at TC service park IN until the last competitor has checked-in at TC service park OUT. These vehicles must be parked in the competitors’ allocated area.

Trailers shall be parked outside the service park in the parking P2: [44°32'17.8"N 6°03'17.8"E](#)

Trucks must be parked in the parking in Lettret: [44°28'27.2"N 6°04'27.8"E](#)

Any vehicle which is not parked inside the competitor’s allocated area in the service park will result in a penalty of 1 500 € per vehicle. Any such application of the regulations by the Clerk of the Course will be notified to the competitor concerned.

6. TWO-WAY RADIO

8. IMPORT OF VEHICLES AND SPARE PARTS

Vehicles from the European Union do not need a specific document for Customs clearance. Only non-EU competitors will need to show an ATA (obtainable from the Chamber of Commerce of the country of origin) to Customs Authorities at their point of entry into the European Union. 9. HELICOPTERS

In accordance with articles L363-1 to L363-3 of the French Environment Code, amended by law no. 2022-217 of February 21, 2022, article 63, which prohibits the landing of aircraft for commercial purposes in mountainous areas (+800m altitude), helicopters intended for VIPs will no longer be authorized.

Only security and television helicopters will be allowed.

10. HOSPITALITY ARRANGEMENTS

Access to the special stages' public zones and to the service park of the 95^e Rallye Automobile Monte-Carlo are free for spectators.

15. START PROCEDURE

The start of the 95^e Rallye Automobile Monte-Carlo will take place on **Thursday, 21st January 2027** at 13:45 - Port Hercule. The holding area and tyre fitting zone preceding the starting podium will be open from 09:00. Each competitor will park in a slot identified by his competition number. Parc Fermé rules will not apply to this holding area and tyre fitting zone.

First car shall drive on the starting podium (TC 0) 3 minutes before its due time for interviews. Following cars shall drive on the starting podium immediately after the previous car has started.

16. FINISH PROCEDURE

After TC 18B, competitors will enter the Parc Fermé.

All competitors must be present in the Parc Fermé at 16:45.

Teams of the top-three competitors in the overall classification and those of the competitors selected for the final scrutineering must arrange for a mechanic to be present beside the podium. The mechanic will retrieve the car from the podium, drive it down and park at the base of it, where a scrutineer will get on board of the cars submitted for the final scrutineering.

18.2 Accreditation procedure

18.2.1 Principles

1. A maximum of three representatives (journalist and/or photographers) per publication may be accredited for the 95^e Rallye Automobile Monte-Carlo.

Only one pass will be issued to websites. Photo, TV or radio tabards are not issued for websites.

2. Agencies must meet the same criteria as publications. The central offices or premises of the main international agencies will be accredited by the FIA.
3. To be accredited, Media must have a distribution that meets criteria of quality and quantity of the FIA.
4. The advertising, public relation, marketing, agencies, etc.... shall in no case be accredited as Media, and Organiser will not issue accreditation to representatives (press officer or otherwise) of sponsors, suppliers, manufacturers, drivers, etc....
5. A Media holding a permanent pass issued by the FIA and wishing an additional accreditation for journalist and/or photographers must apply directly on the FIA website.

18.2.2 Procedures

1. Foreign Media must submit their request on the FIA website before **Monday, 4th January 2027**: <https://acm.mc/en/epreuves/rallye-automobile-monte-carlo/press-area/accreditation-requests/>
2. Monegasque Media must submit their request on the ACM website before **Monday, 21st December 2026**: <https://acm.mc/en/epreuves/rallye-automobile-monte-carlo/press-area/accreditation-requests/>
3. Press photographers under contract with agencies or publications must provide documentation justifying the publication of a minimum of 15 pictures of the previous edition (2026).

4. The request must include:
 - The accreditation form completed;
 - An application for accreditation on an official letterhead paper of the media or agency and signed by the editor or publisher;
 - A copy of the publication and information diffusion (distribution, readership, frequency...) just for first-time applicants;
 - Copies of the published articles covering the 2026 FIA World Rally Championship and possibly those dealing with the Rallye Automobile Monte-Carlo 2026;
 - A photocopy of the press card of the representative who will cover the Rallye Automobile Monte-Carlo 2027;
 - Information on the coverage provided for the Rallye Automobile Monte-Carlo 2027, with details on release dates or broadcast.
5. Documents submitted late and/or incomplete will not be considered.
